



## Pasos Urbanos Activities

**Reimagining Photography** – Inspired by the Museum of History’s exhibit *Pasos Urbanos: A Photographic Narrative of Borderlands Downtown Culture*.

- Old magazines, cards, packaging
- Scissors
- Glue
- A pencil and paper

Make a copy of a photograph in your home or one you’ve taken. You can also use a blank piece of paper to trace the image outlines over the photograph. Use the magazine, cards and packaging to find lots of small pictures of different objects or cut shapes out. Cut out your objects and glue them into your outline and fill the shapes.

**Popsicle Stick Photo Frame** – Inspired by the Museum of History’s exhibit *Pasos Urbanos: A Photographic Narrative of Borderlands Downtown Culture*.

- Craft popsicle sticks
- Photograph or a drawing you made
- Thin cardboard (can be from cut up cereal box)
- Glue stick
- Craft paint
- Stickers, buttons, gems, etc. to decorate
- Yarn
- White craft glue

Directions:

Line up craft sticks in pairs. Place them together in a square and use that to determine how to trim your photo to fit. Remove photo and glue the craft stick together in the shape of a frame. Trace photo onto cardboard and cut out. Attach photo to the cardboard with glue stick. When frame has dried paint it and let it dry. Decorate frame with stickers, buttons, or gems. Turn frame facing down and glue the photo in place. Cut a piece of yarn and glue it at both ends to the back to use as a hanger.
